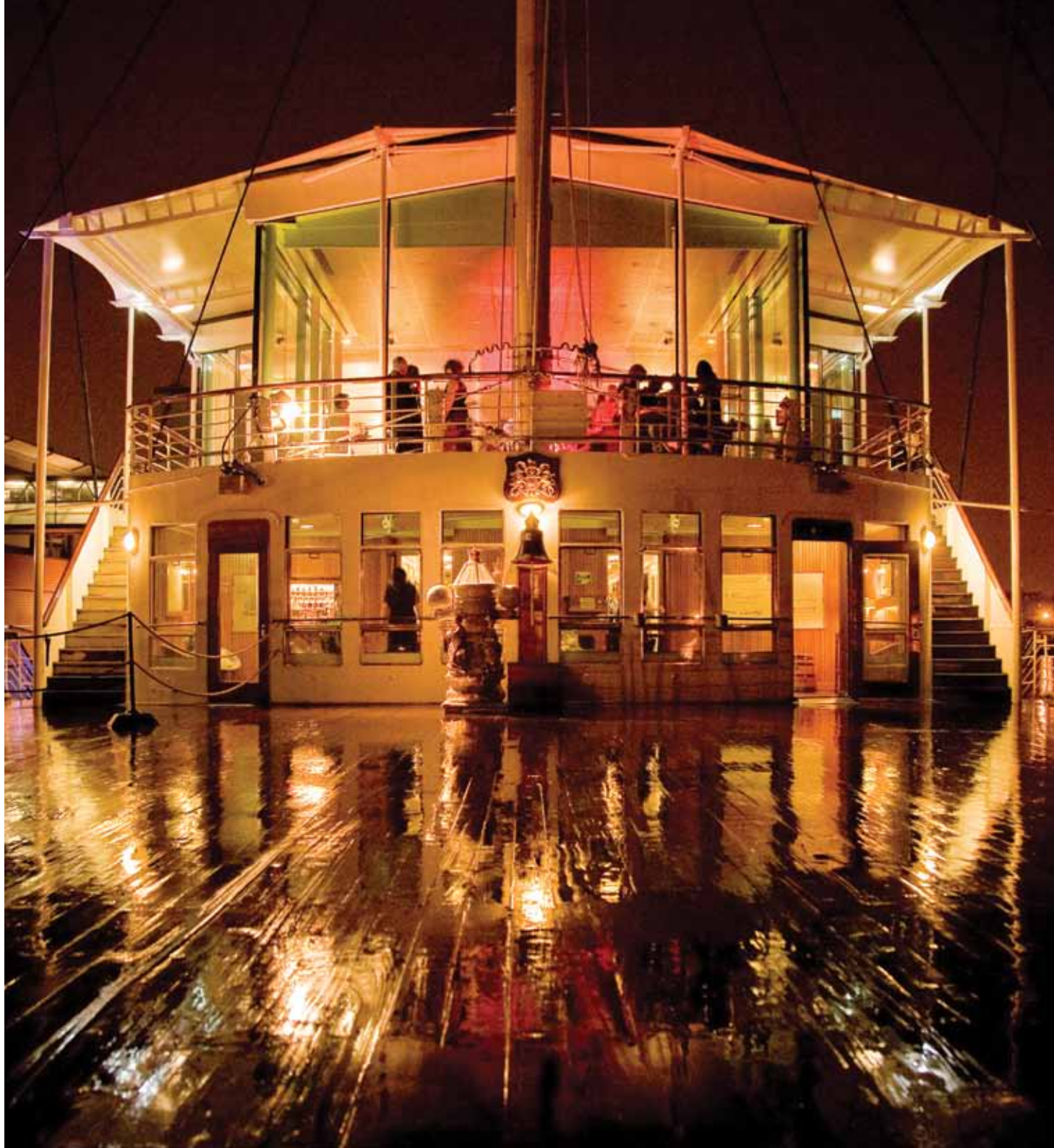






A Royal experience

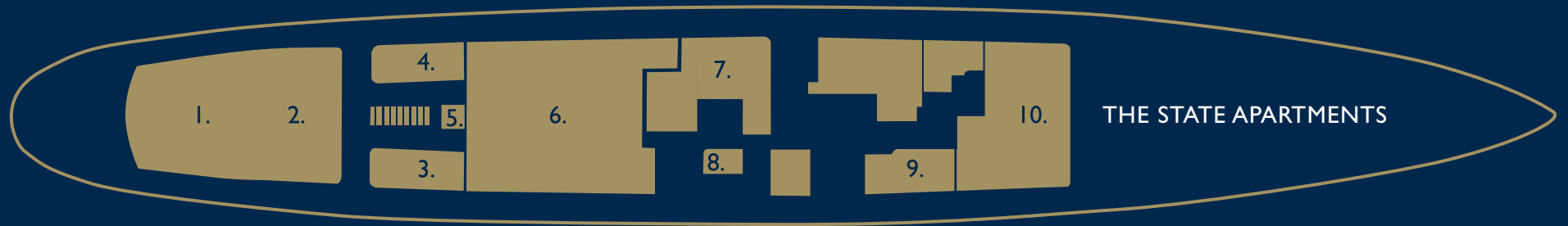

These can be combined for larger numbers.

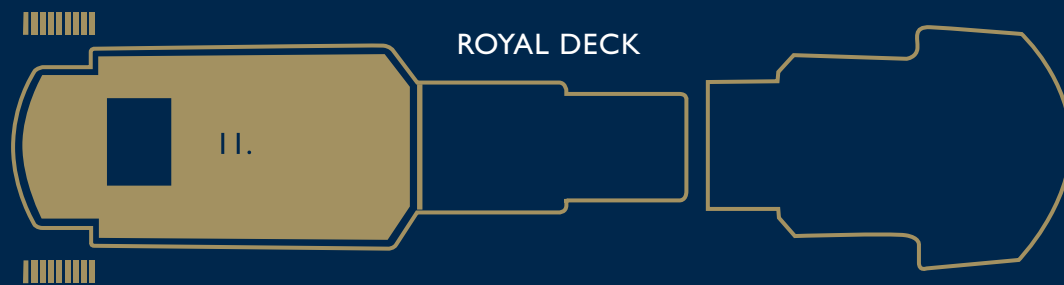


1. With a country house appearance, the State Drawing Room is the perfect place to relax with a glass of champagne, catering for up to 100 people for an evening reception.
