Launched in 2019 in the historic Port of Leith, Fingal is a unique addition to Edinburgh's hotel scene. Following a £5 million development, this former Northern Lighthouse Board ship began an exciting new chapter offering beautiful cabins, fine dining and unique entertaining spaces.

Developed by team behind The Royal Yacht Britannia, Fingal's carefully considered design offers the highest specifications of craftmanship and finish, with nautical touches and polished woods. Sumptuous Scottish leathers and the finest linens are in colour palates inspired by the ship's journey from land and sea.

In 2023, Fingal sailed into the Automobile Association (AA)'s prestigious list of the top luxurious hotels and restaurants in the UK, winning 'Hotel of the Year Scotland'. Fingal was also awarded the top five-star award, plus two AA Rosettes for our Lighthouse Restaurant & Bar.
